Service-Learning Scavenger Hunt next Friday – College of Health Professions' colleagues and students, be sure to make plans to take part in our first-ever Service-Learning Scavenger Hunt.

When? Friday, September 6th, at 12:00 noon

Where? The Courtyard, in the heart of the “west campus”

Why? To meet other College of Health Professions students, faculty, and staff, to have fun, and win prizes. Faculty and staff will be there to cheer you on!

How does this work? You will be divided into teams and given a list of tasks to accomplish or items to “collect.” Most items will be collected with a camera or video recorder. At least one person on the team needs to have a smart phone.

Scavenger Hunt Guidelines

- Teams must stick together. You may not split up and search for items separately and combine your efforts later on. The idea is to play together, not just add up your scores
- Money can't buy everything (alas!). Try not to spend money on any item. The goal is to compete on cleverness, resourcefulness, and speed – not bucks.
- For some goals that do not specifically list a photo or other task, look around and see what might apply to the Scavenger Hunt that is located in that area.
- This is an healthcare campus that is actively taking care of patients and their families. Make sure that you act respectfully with everyone you come in contact with and obey all laws and campus regulations as you are playing.
- All pictures and/or video must be taken during the time allotted for the scavenger hunt, and HIPAA compliance must be maintained at all times. In other words, photos must not include patients or families.
- Each team must work independently of other teams.
- Teams must be respectful to all other teams.
- The scavenger hunt is limited to the UAMS main campus.
- Typical rules of academic honesty apply to this event.
- All determinations by the judges are final.
