Phone-a-Thon pledges exceed \$5000 so far – If you haven't heard, the College of Health Professions' annual scholarship Phone-a-Thon is underway. At last evening's first session of the Phone-a-Thon, students raised \$5,495 in pledges for student scholarships for the coming academic year.

58 students, faculty, and staff from 5 departments called hundreds of alumni and friends of the college and asked them contribute to the college's scholarship funds. The **Department of Imaging and Radiation Sciences** led the way by raising \$1755 in pledges. Other participating departments were:

- **Audiology and Speech Pathology** – \$1200
- **Health Information Management** – \$380
- **Laboratory Sciences** – \$1390
- **Respiratory and Surgical Technologies** – \$770

The Phone-a-Thon continues tonight and Thursday night this week. We expect about 125 more students to help reach our goal of raising \$25,000 to assist students with their educational expenses next year.
