Scholarship Phone-a-Thon sets new record – Upwards of 200 College of Health Professions students made hundreds of phone calls to alumni, donors and friends of the college, and family members this week to raise funds for student scholarships. Their efforts paid off, too. A total of \$19,371 in pledges was raised over the three nights of the 2014 Phone-a-Thon. Pledges mailed in before the Phone-a-Thon will raise the grand total to over \$20,000.

On Thursday night, students from 5 departments raised \$4,221 after a spirited competition between the departments of **Imaging and Radiation Sciences** and **Laboratory Sciences**. In the end, Laboratory Sciences won the contest by raising \$1415; Imaging and Radiation Sciences raised \$1191. Departments participating Thursday evening were:
