Dean's Society will fund up to \$20,000 for projects –

The College of Health Professions Dean's Society invites applications from faculty, staff, or students for funded projects in research, education enhancement, and service-learning for the 2014-2014 academic year. Individual projects may be funded for up to \$5000.

Up to \$2500 of the Dean's Society grant may be used for personnel: (a) to hire students to work on the project or to (b) hire adjunct faculty, teaching assistants, or temporary employees to cover routine responsibilities while the employee is working on the Dean's Society project.

Dean's Society projects should be inter-professional in nature. The grant selection committee prefers applications with team members from different departments, colleges, and institutions, and from outside agencies or the community.
