Who painted that? – If you've recently walked through the lobby of Administration West Building, you can't have missed the four large, new paintings that have been installed. The paintings, titled "*The Ghent Landscape*," are the finishing touches to the lobby renovation – and do they brighten up the space and make it more inviting! A gift from a generous donor, *The Ghent Landscape* was painted in 1978 by Tarrence Corbin. Corbin, who died in 2009, was an associate professor of fine arts at the University of Cincinnati. He is known nationally for his monumental hard-edge paintings such as those in our lobby. He earned his master of fine arts degree at the University of Cincinnati in 1975 and for a time was on the faculty at the University of Arkansas at Pine Bluff (UAPB). While at UAPB, Corbin mentored numerous young artists, including Kevin Cole, now a prominent artist in Atlanta, and Danny Campbell who is a faculty member in the art department at

UAPB. Although we have not received an appraisal for the four-panel work, we believe it is the most valuable piece of art in UAMS's art collection.
