U of A Trustees approve new programs – Last Friday, the University of Arkansas Board of Trustees approved three requests and one notification from the College of Health Professions: (1) Approved the Doctor of Physical Therapy (DPT) program, which will be a new College of Health Professions program offered at the UAMS Northwest campus in Fayetteville. (2) Approved the creation of a Department of Physical Therapy in the College of Health Professions. (3) Approved a new Bachelor of Science in Health Information Administration to be offered through our Department of Health Information Management, chaired by **Kathy Trawick**. (4) Approved notification that the name of our Associate of Science program in Medical Record Technology, offered through the Department of Health Information Management, will be changed to Associate of Science in Health Information Technology beginning fall 2014. The program approval requests will go next to the Arkansas Higher Education Coordinating Board at their meeting on October 25th.
