### FLU VACCINATION CLINIC COLLEGE OF HEALTH PROFESSIONS

Flu vaccinations will be available to College of Health Professions faculty, staff, and students, as well as those in the UAMS Bookstore and other Administration West offices at no charge on **October 23, 2013, from 10:00 am – 12:00 pm** in the **College of Health Professions Student Study Center (Building 6A)**. You'll need to show your UAMS ID Badge to receive the vaccine.

Please notify your department administrator if you will be participating so that the representatives from Employee/Student Health will know how much vaccine is needed. Flu vaccines will not be available in the Student and Employee Health Services clinics until November 1<sup>st</sup>, so employees and students are encouraged to take advantage of our on-site vaccination clinic – shorter lines, less time waiting.

Flu vaccinations are **mandatory** for all UAMS employees and students. See the [Administrative Guide Policy](#) for details. You may request a [medical exemption or a religious exemption](#). The deadline for requesting an exemption is November 8.

### **All vaccinations must be completed by Friday, November 22.**

Distance students and employees working outside of Pulaski County may receive their vaccine by contacting the employee health nurse at their local Regional Center. If you aren't sure where to find the closest Regional Center, please contact your department or program administrator or call the College of Health Professions Welcome Center at (501) 686-5730.

If you are unable to come to the CHP Flu Vaccination Clinic, additional dates in October and November are available, and will include some weekend clinics. See [Mass Flu Shot Locations 2013-2014](#)

If you get your flu shot elsewhere (your doctor, Walgreen, etc.) be sure to get written documentation that you received a shot. The documentation must be to the administrator of your department before the November deadline to confirm that you have complied with UAMS
