Accreditors give Sonography 10 years X

Our programs in General, Vascular, and Cardiac Sonography were awarded the maximum time for accreditation – 10 years! Congratulations to program director **Tony Baker** (left) and the

Speaking of accreditation . . . Our Center for Dental Education has reached an important, new milestone in the development of dental education in Arkansas. On Thursday, September 25, the center will host visitors from CODA (Commission on Dental Accreditation) who will review our application for accreditation of our dental General Practice Residency (GPR) program.

Dental residency programs are offered for dentists who have completed their dental degree and want to pursue advanced education. Our GPR will be one year long and will focus on advanced general practice and hospital dentistry. We plan to admit the first two residents in July 2015.

GPR residents will spend much of their time in the UAMS Oral Health Clinic, adjacent to our dental hygiene clinic. They will also complete "rotations" in several areas of the hospital including surgery, otolaryngology (ear-nose-throat), emergency medicine, internal medicine, anesthesiology, and a rotation at Arkansas Children's Hospital.
