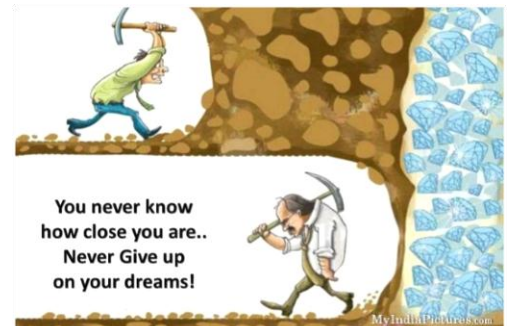

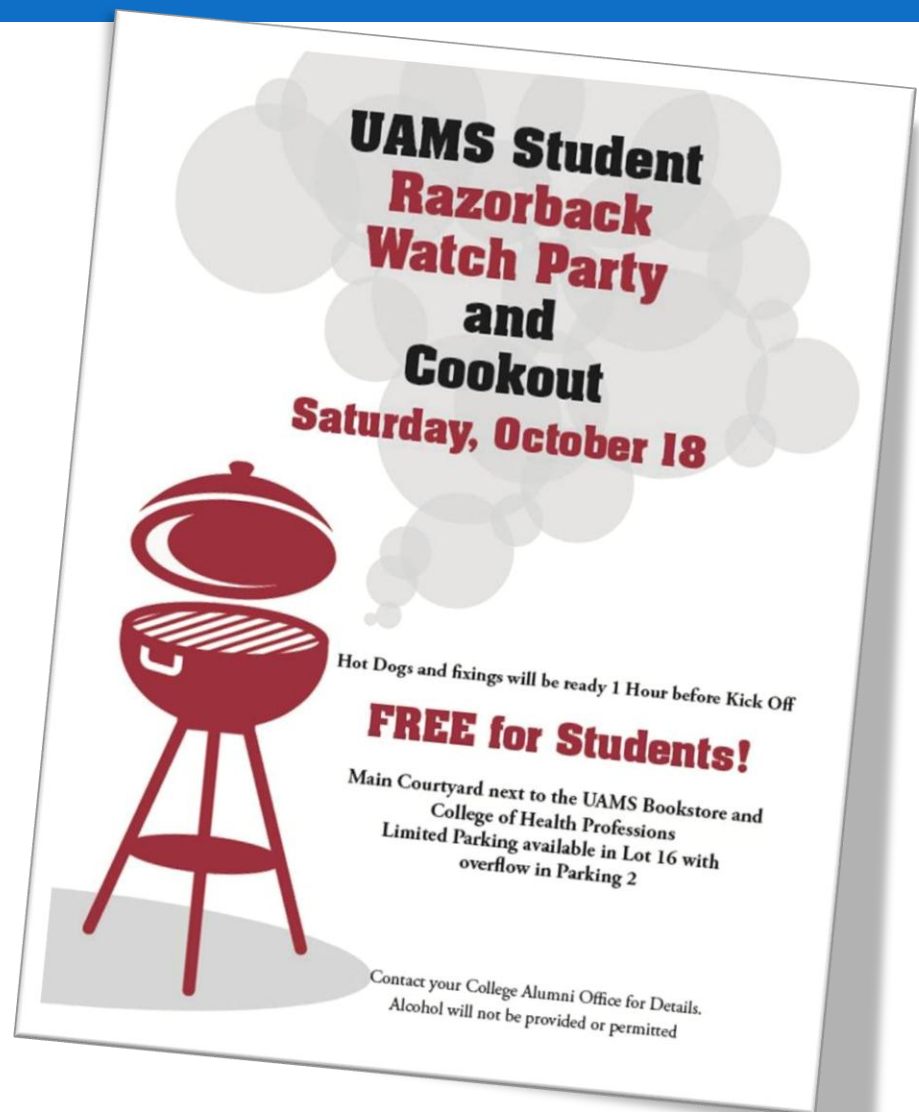

## NEW UAMS Student Services Center

The rigors of health professions education can be demanding, and UAMS is dedicated to providing the resources to assist students meet this challenge. The new Student Success Center opened on October 1<sup>st</sup> offering expanded academic resources to aid all UAMS students.

Located on the third floor of the UAMS Library, the center offers student-focused services including resources for assessment of academic difficulties and referrals to appropriate support, a new writing and presentation Center, expanded peer tutoring services, assistance with improving study

and test-taking skills, window-of-opportunity and special testing, and a new "one-stop shop" website outlining the various resources available at UAMS.

The Center also provides assistance with laptops and mobile services. Mr. Nicholas Larsen, Student Support/Technology Analyst, is available to assist with various technology issues, from connecting to the wireless network to troubleshooting possible hard drive issues. 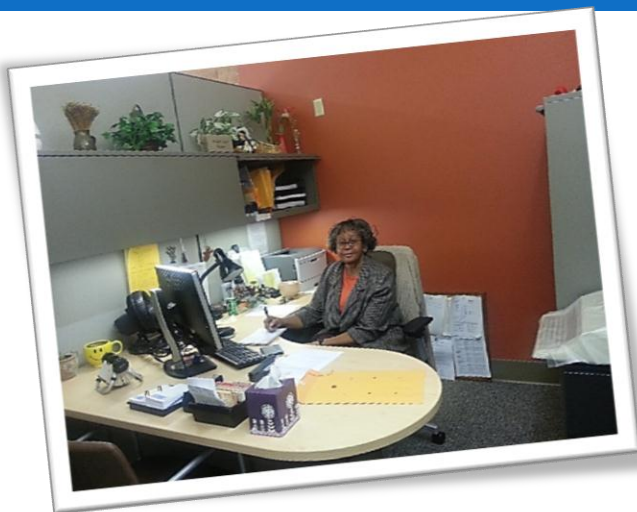
