Dodd Wilson, Room 226 for this action packed workshop designed to guide you through the promotion and tenure (P&T) process. This workshop is divided into three parts: didactic, applied, and hands-on. First, the PTC will introduce you to the P&T guidelines and workshop activities while you eat your lunch.

Following lunch, get ready for some fast paced generative activities to practice the skills you need to get on the right track. Finally, you will have the opportunity to visit with PTC members at round tables to ask questions and to review examples of successful P&T dossier and evidence binders.
