Big night at the Phonathon last night – Congratulations to about 40 College of Health Professions students who spent 2 hours on Monday evening calling college alumni, friends, and family members, asking them to make donations for student scholarships. A total of almost **\$9400** in pledges was raised by students from 8 of the college's 12 academic departments. The top performer was **Physician Assistant Studies**, who raised over \$2020. Other totals were:

- Audiology and Speech Pathology - \$1120
- Dental Hygiene - \$1845
- Genetic Counseling - \$395
- Health Information Management - \$510
- Diagnostic Medical Sonography - \$1005
- Nuclear Medicine Imaging Sciences - \$550
- Radiologic Imaging Sciences - \$660
- Ophthalmic Medical Technology - \$885
- Respiratory Care - \$405

Adding their support to the scholarship effort were **Judy Sims** and **Deborah French**, two members of the college's Advisory Board.
