Physician assistant students win 1st place –

Congratulations to **Tabitha Jagers, Mira Patel,** and **Alli Brooks** on winning the 1st place prize in the Professional Student Category at Wednesday's UAMS Student Research Day poster competition. These third-year Physician Assistant students' poster was titled "*The Effectiveness of Intravenous Ketamine Infusions in Treating Comorbid Major Depression Disorder and Posttraumatic Stress Disorder.*"

The poster presented a clinical case, current research literature pertinent to the case, critique of the literature, and conclusions based on research findings. The project was the product of the students' capstone project that they undertook with the direction of **Vania Naydenova**, assistant professor of Physician Assistant Studies. Bobby McGehee, dean of the UAMS Graduate School, remarked that ". . . just for the record, Tabitha [and Mira and Alli were] up against some very stiff competition. So major kudos!!" This is the first year that Physician Assistant students have participated in UAMS Student Research Day.
