Respiratory care selected for award – On April 13, Tom Jones, director of the Respiratory Care program, received notice that the program will receive the *Distinguished RRT Credentialing Success Award*. The award, given by the Commission on Accreditation for Respiratory Care (CoARC) is given to a select group of respiratory care education programs in the U.S. that: (1) have 3 or more years outcome data, (2) hold accreditation without a progress report, (3) document board examination success of 90% or better, and (4) meet or exceed CoARC's thresholds for credentialing success, student attrition, and positive job placement. Our program has received this award for several years in a row, attesting to its success in fostering student excellence.
