Subject: Adding and Dropping Courses

POLICY

Students have until the close of the announced registration period to add or drop courses for the subsequent semester without penalty. A student may add courses, if approved by the course instructor and the student's faculty advisor/department chairman, within ten working days after the first day of classes.

A student may drop a class using the appropriate form with the required signatures and fee until the fifth day of class. No notation will appear on the transcript concerning the deletion of a course. Refund of tuition and fees will be based on the schedule established in UAMS Academic Affairs Policy 3.1.5.

Students who withdraw by the established date on the College of Health Professions Academic Calendar will receive a "W" (withdraw); those who withdraw after the established date for a "W" mark will receive either a "WP" (withdraw passing) or "WF" (withdraw failing). The deadlines for course withdrawals are five working days before the end of the semester. A mark of "WF" is averaged into the GPA as a grade of "F." A grade of "WP" is not averaged into the GPA.

The appropriate form for the adding and dropping of courses may be obtained from the Office of the University Registrar.
