Steps in the Application Process - Admissions

Materials to be sent to Graduate School at UAMS:

- Online application for admission to UAMS Graduate School (<https://online-apps.uams.edu/gsl/>)
- Official** Graduate Record Examination (GRE) scores (You must have taken the GRE within the past 5 years, or you will need to retake it)
- Official** transcripts for **all** colleges/universities attended (graduate and undergraduate)
- Three letters of reference (2 of 3 minimum from most recent academic program)
