Cytotechnology students to present at national conference - again – For the seventh year in a row – yes, 7 years – UAMS Cytotechnology students have been invited to make presentations at the [American Society for Cytotechnology's](#) annual scientific conference in San Antonio, Texas on April 28-30. Four students will present cytology cases. Two were selected for the computer presentation category.

Two others were selected for oral presentations and will be included in ASCT's Student Case Presentation Competition against other cytology students from around the nation. Incidentally, UAMS's Cytotechnology students won second place in the national competition in 2016. Students and presentations are:
