Clinical nutrition student is "people's choice" – Taren

Swindle, master of science student in clinical nutrition, was the winner of the People's Choice Award at the UAMS Graduate School's semi-final 3MT Competition on March 28. Her presentation, "A Qualitative Exploration of Organizational Facilitators and Barriers to Mealtime and Nutrition Promotion Practices of Early Childhood Educators," was selected for the award by audience members attending the competition. Josh Phelps, assistant professor in the College of Health Profession's Department of Dietetics and Nutrition, was Taren's project advisor, and Reza Hakkak, department chair, and Tina Crook, director of the Dietetics Internship program, served on her project committee. Congratulations to Taren, Josh, Reza, and Tina.

Taren is assistant professor in the Department of Family and



Preventive Medicine. She was able to pursue her master's degree in clinical nutrition with the support of a KL2 grant through UAMS's Translational Research Institute. Her research focuses on preventing obesity and promoting good nutrition for young children in low-income families. She is interested in increasing the adoption of evidence-based practice and interventions in community settings to reduce obesity and improve nutrition.

This is the first year that UAMS has organized Student Research Day activities around 3MT (Three Minute Thesis), which was founded by the University of Queensland in Australia. Presenters create and present an engaging, clear, and concise three-minute talk intended for a non-specialist audience.
