Why our program?

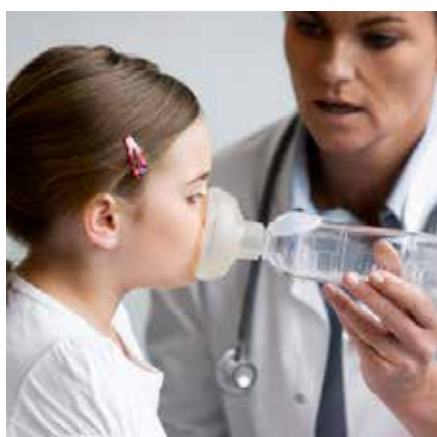
- Only Bachelor of Science degree program offered in Arkansas
