

The Department of Dietetics and Nutrition at UAMS will offer the following courses on-line for summer semester 2021 – Semester dates run May 24th through August 3rd, 2021.

NUTR 5107 Advanced Clinical Nutrition; Summer semester (5/24 – 8/3)

Integration of principles of biochemistry, physiology, pathology, anatomy, psychology, anthropology, epidemiology, nutrition and food science into therapeutic use of foods and nutrients in disease prevention and treatment through a case-oriented approach. Prerequisites include Biochemistry, Diet in Disease, Anatomy and Physiology, or consent of faculty. (3 credit hours) Course instructor is Christi Arthur, MS RD LD CSP CNSC.

NUTR 5109 Medical Nutrition Therapy; Summer semester (5/24 – 8/3)

On-line course introducing nutrition as a medical specialty from the perspective of disease prevention and treatment including assessment, patient interviewing strategies, medical terminology, nutrition care plan techniques, and prevention strategies. Prerequisites: a course in nutrition and in organic biochemistry, physiology or equivalent, or consent of faculty. (3 credit hours) Course instructor is Christi Arthur, MS RD LD CSP CNSC.

Summer 2021 students will matriculate after May 1st **Regular registration will begin on May 3rd – May 23rd. Late registration is May 24th– May 26th.**

Students must be approved to take these courses and should complete the application for approval at <http://gradschool.uams.edu/pros-students/non-degree-seeking>. An email notification will be sent to you and if approved, you will be sent registration information. You must be admitted for this program by May 1st. Applications that are not complete or submitted at that time will not be approved for the Summer 2021 term.
